

Dublin City Ordinances You Should Be Familiar With

Weeds and Tall Grasses- Allowing the weeds and grass to grow to a height of greater than twelve inches creates a health, sanitation, and fire safety hazard and becomes a nuisance to the community. **Ordinance 10-22-01-99**

Trash and Debris- Allowing the accumulation of rubbish and brush and other objectionable, unsightly and unsanitary items upon any property within the City does not promote a safe, healthy environment and requires that regulations be established for the betterment of the City as a whole. **Ordinance 10-22-01-08**

Abandon/Junk Vehicles – this regulates abandoned motor vehicles and junk vehicles within the City in order to preserve and protect the public health and safety and to preserve the quality of life and property values. Contact Code Enforcement should you have questions re: definition of junk or abandon vehicles. **Ordinance 10-22-01-7**

Burning – Prohibits burning of litter, solid waste, garbage, trash and vegetative substances as it impairs the quality of life and is injurious to the economic development of our community. Contact Code Enforcement should you have questions re: Burning and Control Burns **Ordinance 07-12-04-2**

Address Numbers – Street address numbers shall be a minimum of (3”) in height each and be placed on the street side of the building. The numbers must be of a distinctly different color than the structure on which the numbers are attached.
