

High Grass & Weeds

Not only are high grass and weeds unsightly eyesores on our City; but they pose a fire hazard, block visibility for drivers, harbor rodents and snakes, and contribute to pests like mosquitoes and chiggers. Fort Worth city code says that property owners are responsible for maintaining their yards and vacant lots, and that grass and weeds that average over 12 inches high are a violation.

To stay within Code, you should keep your yard and vacant lots mowed to less than 12 inches. If your grass is taller than 12 inches, you will receive a certified notice (once per year) and will have 10 days to mow it. Failure to pay for mowing may result in a lien being placed against the property.
