



Pool Rules

2023

The following rules and regulations have been established for the benefit of all users of the swimming pool to assure the safe operation of the pool facilities and to provide enjoyable recreation for all. Guests are requested to cooperate in observing these rules and to obey the instructions of the pool staff. Guests violating swimming rules are subject to the revocation of their swimming privileges. We reserve the right to ask Guests to leave at any time.

The City of Dublin reserves the right to refuse admittance into the pool when the capacity of the pool has been reached or when otherwise deemed necessary for the health, welfare, or safety of the Guests.

The City of Dublin welcomes Guests to enjoy the use of all its facilities without regard to race, sex, age, color, creed, national origin, marital status, sexual orientation, gender identity, or disability. The Pool Manager or their designated assistants are responsible for the operation of the pools. Their instruction must always be followed.

1. All swimmers entering the pool must pay or present a pass. No person may use the pool unless it is officially open and lifeguards are on duty.
2. Admission to the pool may be denied for any of the following reasons:
 - a. Intoxication. No alcohol at the park or inside the pool area. Lifeguards are permitted to check all coolers, bags, and any containers.
 - b. Open sores, wounds, skin infections, and nasal or ear discharge. Do not swim if you have been ill with diarrhea within the past 2 weeks.
 - c. Any condition or evidence, which in the opinion of the Head Lifeguard or designee will jeopardize the health and safety of other Guests.
3. Absolutely no swimming without a lifeguard on duty.
4. NO DIVING! AT ANY TIME!! Any patron found diving into the pool will be automatically asked to leave the pool.
5. NO running, pushing, fighting or rough play of any kind will be tolerated. It could cause undue disturbance, or endanger the welfare of self or other Guests.
6. Changing diapers within 6 feet of the pool is prohibited.
7. Persons under the age of 14 must not be in the pool without adult supervision (a lifeguard is not considered adult supervision)
8. EXTENDED BREATH HOLDING ACTIVITIES ARE DANGEROUS AND PROHIBITED
9. A swim test will be conducted at the discretion of the lifeguards. If swimmer does not pass the test, they must stay in water that is not over their shoulders.
10. Flotation devices will be permitted at the lifeguard's discretion. Flotation devices that are allowed: Pool noodles, floaties, life vest, inflatable beach balls, or sponge balls. Not allowed: Water rafts or inter tubes. An adult must be within arm's reach of a child.
11. Proper swimming attire is required to enter the pool.
 - a. NO cut-offs jeans, thongs or revealing swim wear.
 - b. Clothing with plastic or metal rivets, zippers or ornamentation are not allowed in the pool.
 - c. Clothing that is revealing or has vulgar content is not permitted.
12. Infants/children under the age of 3 are required to wear swim diapers.
13. Improper public displays of affection and profanity are prohibited and will not be tolerated.
14. Food and drinks are permitted inside pool area, not inside the pool. Patron is responsible for picking up trash and cleaning area. The City of Dublin reserves the right to search coolers and bags for prohibited items.
15. GLASS containers, breakable objects, weapons, illegal controlled substances of any kind, are not permitted inside the pool area, restrooms, or outside surrounding pool areas.
16. Children under 48 inches tall must be supervised by an adult age 18 or older, while using the slide(s). For the safety our Guests using the slide, we will enforce the slide rules recommended by the manufacturer.

17. All injuries occurring within the pool area or restrooms must be reported to the Head Lifeguard or designee on duty immediately.
18. Children's strollers must remain *at least* 6 feet from the side of the pool.
19. Smoking, vaping, or the use of tobacco products is prohibited
20. No pets are allowed in the pool area, except for service dogs. Service dogs are not allowed in the pool.
21. To maintain the privacy of our guests, camera images should be restricted to your family and friends. Conventional and cell phone cameras are strictly prohibited in locker rooms and restrooms.
22. The Dublin City Pool assumes no liability for the loss or theft of member's personal belongings. Items left in pool area at the end of the day will be placed in the pool's lost and found.
23. The City Manager, Certified Pool Operator (CPO), Director of Public Works, or City Secretary/Supervisor of lifeguards may close the entire pool complex, or any portions of the pool complex for any safety or maintenance reason.
24. The City Manager, Certified Pool Operator (CPO), Director of Public Works, City Secretary, Head Lifeguard, and Supervisor of lifeguards on duty have the authority to enforce these rules and may remove any patron who violates these rules from the Dublin City Pool.
25. Parties held at the pool: Guest holding party will be responsible for cleaning inside pool area and bathrooms the last 30 minutes of their scheduled time.
26. GUESTS MUST OBEY ALL PARK RULES AND FOLLOW THE DIRECTIONS OF THE LIFEGUARDS AND ADMINISTRATION STAFF, OR PATRON(S) WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE PARK.
